

Environmental *update*

Your electricity supplier is required to provide you with periodic environmental disclosure information on fuel sources and air emissions for the electricity supply purchased on your behalf.

- ▶ **If you receive your electricity supply from RG&E**, your environmental disclosure information is provided here. It is also available at rge.com.
- ▶ **If you buy electricity from a supplier other than RG&E, and are billed directly by your supplier**, you should receive environmental disclosure information from your supplier.

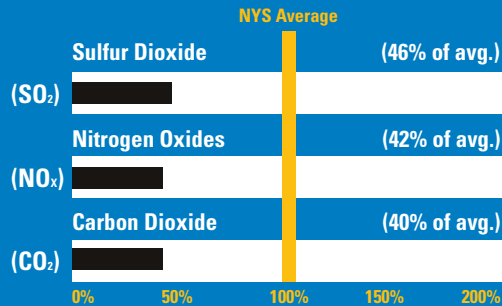

▶ **FOR YOUR ELECTRICITY SUPPLY**

As an RG&E electricity customer, you will again be asked to choose your electricity **supplier** and select a **fixed or variable** electricity supply pricing option, through RG&E's *Voice Your Choice* program.

Just like last year, you can choose to purchase your electricity supply from RG&E or another energy supplier (called an energy services company or ESCO).

If you do not choose an electricity supply pricing option, your account will automatically be enrolled in the Variable Price Option of your current electricity supplier.
