Energy Efficiency Programs

The program is available to RG&E electricity customers. Refrigerators and freezers must be in working condition, owned by the resident and must be a minimum of 10 cubic feet in size, using inside measurements. RG&E contracts with JACO Environmental, an appliance recycler, to pick up and recycle refrigerators and freezers. Limit two units per residential address per year. Cannot be combined with any other offer. This program may be terminated at any time due to funding constraints. Some restrictions apply.

RG&E is offering residential natural gas customers rebates for installing qualifying natural gas equipment and related control equipment completed on or after April 1, 2011.

The rebates are funded through the System Benefits Charge that appears on customer bills.

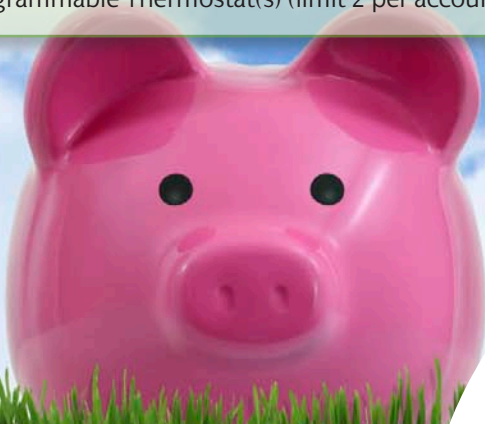
