Streetlight upgrades planned for 650 lights

We are replacing 650 lights across six circuits in the town of Brighton and the village of Pittsford over the next few years. These investments are part of our commitment to improve service and reliability. We are replacing two historic streetlight circuits that have been in operation for almost 100 years, upgrading more than 250 streetlights between Monroe and Highland Avenue.

We worked with the community and the Brighton Historic Preservation Committee to install special lighting that will maintain the existing historical appearance and style of the streetlights in the area. Incandescent arc bulbs will be upgraded to modern LED bulbs, improving system reliability and making it safer for pedestrians.



Generator safety tips

If severe weather knocks out your power, please review these safety tips before using your portable or permanent generator.

- Read, understand and follow the manufacturer's instructions.
- Operate your generator outdoors in a clean, dry, well-ventilated area and never indoors or in a garage.
- Do not overload generator with too many appliances.
- Never attach a portable generator directly to the electrical system of your home.
- Use properly sized extension cords in good condition.

Winter safety tips

- Electric and natural gas meters and regulators should be kept clear of ice and snow by using a broom or by hand – not a shovel.
- Never bury electric or natural gas meters, natural gas pipes or natural gas regulators with snow.
- Please clear a pathway to outside meters so we have clear and safe access.
- Natural gas chimneys and vents should be kept clear of snow and ice to prevent the build-up of carbon monoxide.
