

EDI Testing Qualification Checklist for Distributed Energy Resources (DERs)

A DER applying to EDI test at NYSEG and/or RG&E must first:

- 1. Be approved by New York State Department of Public Service as DER. https://documents.dps.ny.gov/PTC/der
- 2. Meet NYS Department of Public Service Commission electronic data interchange (EDI) Phase 1 certification for Utility Bill Ready (UBR) transactions.
- 3. Complete/provide below Documentation list and email to supplier_relations@rge.com.
