

Important information for ESCO customers

We collect a number of taxes in our bills and pass those taxes on to state and local governmental entities.

Until now, we did not collect a local municipal tax on the delivery portion of revenues for customers who receive their electricity or natural gas supply from an Energy Services Company (ESCO).

The local municipalities listed on the back of this insert have ordered us to begin collecting a local municipal tax on the delivery portion of ESCO customer bills.

If this request from your city or village (see list on reverse) affects your bill, the new municipal tax will be included in the "Taxes on delivery charges" line item on this and future bills. If this tax is not included in your bill, this notice does not apply to you.

This tax is collected and remitted to your city or village. We do not retain any of the municipal tax.

Please note that this tax does not affect all ESCO customers, only those located in the cities and villages listed on the back of this insert.
