- Receive alerts for other locations like your camp or an elderly parent's home.

Sign up for Meter Read Reminder Alerts

Our Meter Read Reminder Alerts let you know when we're scheduled to read your RG&E meter and/or when you can provide your own meter reading on the months when we're scheduled to estimate your usage for billing or when it's inconvenient for you to provide us access.

Your benefits from actual meter readings include:

- Bills based on your actual energy usage.
- Easy tracking of your energy usage.
- You can understand and link your energy usage to how you use appliances.
- When you understand your usage, you can manage it.

When you sign up for our Meter Read Reminder Alerts, you'll:

- · Receive an alert by text, phone, or email when your meter is scheduled to be read by us or when your customer meter reading is due.
- Receive alerts only when you want them: monthly, only when we're scheduled to read your meter, and/or or when we're scheduled to estimate your usage for billing.

Natural gas safety tips

We work diligently to ensure your safety. Here's what you can to do keep you and your family safe.

Use your senses to stay safe

A natural gas leak is usually recognized by smell, sight or sound.

- SMELL For your safety, a distinctive sulfur-like odor, similar to rotten eggs, is added to natural gas. Note: Not all natural gas in larger transmission lines is odorized.
- SIGHT You may see a white cloud, mist, fog, bubbles in standing water or blowing dust. You may also see vegetation that appears to be dead or dying for no apparent reason.
- SOUND You may hear an unusual noise like roaring, hissing or whistling.

Suspect a natural gas leak? Get up, get out and call us immediately from another location at 1.800.743.1702 or call 911

- DO NOT use a phone, smoke or operate electrical switches or appliances. They may produce a spark that might ignite the natural gas and cause an explosion.
- DO NOT assume someone else will report the condition.
- Provide the exact location, including cross streets.
- Let us know if you notice sewer construction or digging activities are in progress.
